TUTORIAL REQUIREMENTS

• Length: Tutorials can be either half-day (4 hours, including breaks) or full-day (8 hours, including breaks).

The following information must be included in the proposal:

- Title of the tutorial
- Abstract: Approximately 300 words
- Target audience
- Prerequisites

IMPORTANT DATE

- Course Outline: List of covered topics and timeframes for each topic. A full-day tutorial should allow for at least 7.5 hours of instruction, excluding breaks.
- Summary of topics: A brief description of what is covered in each topic.
- Presenter names and biographies: Approximately 150 words for each presenter.
- Email addresses: Of the organizer and presenters.

O Proposal Submissions Due: 10th January 2025

O Final Decision Due: 31st March 2025

O Final Presentation Due: 12th May 2025
